<b>Conclusions</b>	Thoughtful insight was used to demonstrate the student has understood the book and can appreciate it for its informational value	There is a conclusion, but not much insight into overall opinions on the book.	An attempt at a conclusion is made.	No conclusion to wrap up the thoughts about the book.
<b>Paper Length and Format</b>	Fills length requirement and in a format that is consistent	Fills length but does not follow a format	Does not meet the length requirement but does follow a format	Does not meet the length requirement nor is in a consistent
<b>Grammar &amp; Spelling (Conventions)</b>	Writer makes no errors in grammar or spelling that distracts the reader from the content.	Writer makes 1-2 errors in grammar or spelling that distract the reader from the content.	Writer makes 3-4 errors in grammar or spelling that distract the reader from the content.	Writer makes more than 4 errors in grammar or spelling that distracts the reader from the content.
